The work wants to follow a simple concept: what seems simple in appearance is complex in its structure, exactly like human thought. Lines that have neither a beginning nor an end they represent the human brain and are formed in one dark and light-free room, unconscious. The synapsic lines, despite appearing in a state of stasis, are constantly being remodeled and readjusted; just like our brain activity which is static for memories, but dynamic for thoughts.
